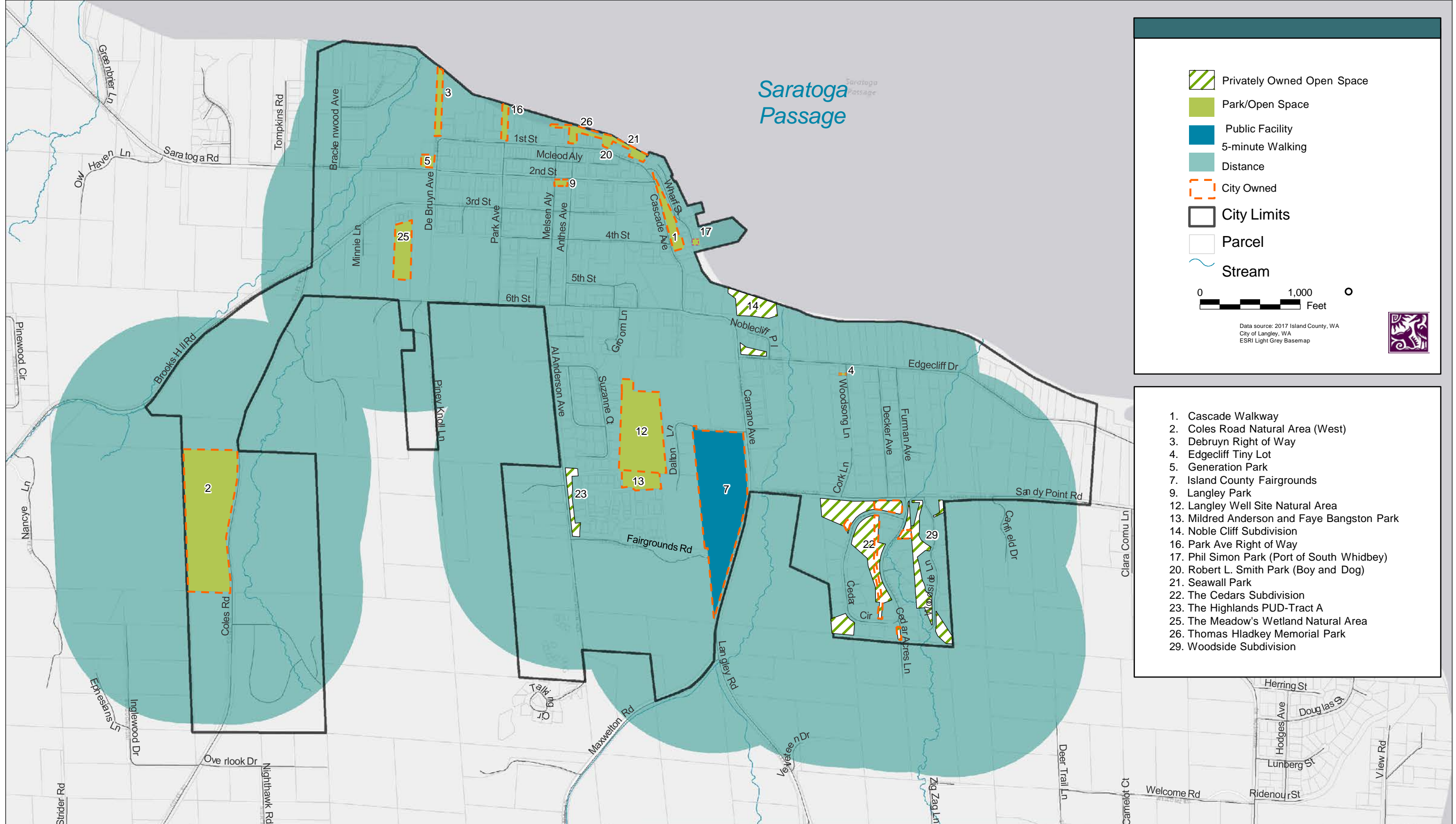


Figure POS-3 Langley Park Walkability
