**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LANGLEY, WASHINGTON**, amending Ordinance No. 840 and Title 14 of the Langley Municipal Code with regard to the City Boat Harbor Regulations

**THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANGLEY, WASHINGTON, DO  
HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Ordinance No. 840 and Langley Municipal Code Section 14.01.030 is hereby amended to read as follows:

**14.01.030 Transient moorage.**

A. Transient moorage rates shall be set by resolution or ordinance of the city council.

B. Continuous moorage by one boat, at the moorage facility, is limited to fourteen (14) consecutive nights within a thirty-day (30) period, except for those boats with annual or winter moorage contracts. Changing slips or leaving the moorage facility temporarily and returning shall not affect this limit. The thirty-day (30) period starts with the first day of moorage. (Ord. 840, 2003)

C. All vessels using the boat harbor must register and pay, upon arrival either a day moorage fee (if leaving before 8 PM) or overnight moorage based on the City's fee schedule. Failure of a boat owner to register and pay moorage shall be a civil infraction and shall be punishable as such by a civil penalty of up to \$500. In addition, if an owner fails to register and pay moorage, after being notified of the infraction, then the harbormaster or his/her designee may take measures to secure the vessel as provided in section 14.01.100 herein.

Section 2. Severability. If any section, paragraph, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is held invalid for any reason, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.

Section 3. Effective Date. This ordinance shall take effect five (5) days after the date of posting and publication of an approved summary thereof, consisting of the title.
