The Policy Process Coordinators (minus the City Clerk who is absent for medical reasons) forward for Council consideration the following four potential policy changes and/or additions:

PPC 08-005, Parks and Open Space Plan
PPC 08-006, Subdivision Regulations
PPC 08-007, Population Projection
PPC 08-008, Heritage Tree Protection

In accordance with the recently adopted procedures, the City Council, with input from administration, staff and the public, shall decide 1) whether the idea will move forward at this time, 2) who will take the next step, 3) what priority it will have in the workflow, 4) how long it should be worked on and 5) which policy process coordinator will oversee the work. To assist in this process, the Policy Process Coordinators have made recommendations on answers to questions 2, 4 and 5.

If an idea is to move forward, then the Council must decide if the potential policy change will follow the "simple issue" or the "complex issue" track. The latter track will result in the development of a range of options following research that will be presented to the Council at a subsequent meeting.
