

**CITY OF LANGLEY, WASHINGTON**

**AN ORDINANCE of the City of Langley, Washington adopting  
the 2009 Annual City Operating Budget.**

WHEREAS, the City Clerk-Treasurer has provided the City Council with current information on estimates of revenues and expenditures for the coming year; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the City's total anticipated financial requirements for the ensuing fiscal year; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing on General Government Revenues was held on November 17, 2008 and a public hearing to take comment on the draft budget was also held on that date;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LANGLEY, WASHINGTON, DO HEREBY ORDAIN as follows:

Section 1. The City Council hereby adopts the City Budget for the year 2008 in the estimated amount of revenue and appropriations of the City's various funds as follows:
