AWC Center for Quality Communities Scholarship

Dear student,

Thank you for your interest in applying for the AWC Center for Quality Communities Scholarship. The City of Langley will be selecting and nominating one graduating senior for a \$1000 scholarship from the Association of Washington Cities Center for Quality Communities. In addition the local nominee will receive a \$500 scholarship from the Friends of the Langley Library. Students living within the South Whidbey School District boundaries, and graduating from high school, home school or receiving a GED by the end of June 2012, are eligible to apply.

The scholarship is available through a competitive process for students who are actively engaged in their community and/or city government. Four scholarships will be awarded statewide. Applicants must be Washington residents and plan to continue their education in fall 2012 at an accredited college, community college, or trade school, on at least a half-time basis.

IMPORTANT DATES:

- **DEADLINE: Thursday, February 23, 2012 by 5:00 PM.** Applications can be mailed, or dropped off at the front desk at city hall next to the Langley Library.
- **INTERVIEWS: Thursday, March 1, 2012 between 3 – 5:30 PM.** The top candidates will be invited for an interview with the Langley Library Board selection committee.
- **NOMINATION: Monday, March 5, 2012 at 5:30 PM.** The selection committee will recommend the nominee for city council approval at the first council meeting in March.
- **AWARD:** The nominee will be notified by AWC by mail in May 2012.
