

MINUTES – LANGLEY HISTORIC PRESERVATION COMMISSION
November 8, 2011
Langley City Hall

Present: Marty Fernandez, Niki Barr, David Rogan-Levine, Aaron Coates, Bob Waterman.

Chair Bob Waterman called the meeting to order at 3:00 pm.

Bob asked if there were corrections to the September 13, 2011 minutes. **Marty moved to accept the minutes as submitted. David seconded the motion and the minutes were adopted unanimously.**

OLD BUSINESS.

A. Possible Register Nominations

Adam Voelker house : Bob reported that Linda had mailed a letter to the owner as a follow up to her previous contact expressing the interest by the HPC in nominating the Adam Voelker house for placement on the Register of Historic Places.

Breedlove House: Niki reported that she is still waiting to set up a meeting with Abe Luhn. She hopes this will occur soon, and anticipates that the nomination form for the house will be completed with the information he can provide.

Bushby House: Marty has met with owner Faith Bushby who is amenable to exploring the nomination. He plans to follow up.

Pole Building: Bob has spoken with Island County Commissioner, Helen Price-Johnson, and Dianne Divelbess of the Island County Fair Board regarding ownership and willingness to place the Pole Building located on the Fairgrounds on the Register of Historic Places. Both expressed willingness to proceed, but suggested he speak with Sandy Brandon, Fair administrator. He will do so.

Middle School: Bob reported that he had made a presentation to the school board prior to the change in leadership. He expressed a desire to follow up with the new superintendent and board. This suggestion was viewed favorably by the HPC.

B. Plaque Update

David reported that he had communicated with a supplier in Canon Beach, and is waiting to hear back. The consensus of the Commissioners was to go with an aluminum plaque.

C. Walking Tour Booklet Update

David expressed willingness to produce a hard copy booklet of a walking tour in a "Z-Card" format. Bob will provide an editable copy of the booklet produced by Harrison Goodall to use as a starting point.

In addition, a lengthy discussion ensued regarding the and scope and most appropriate format for an electronic version. David and Marty will explore possibilities and report back at the December meeting.

NEW BUSINESS.

Because of time constraints, no new business was discussed.

There being no further business, Marty moved to adjourn. Niki seconded the motion, and members unanimously voted to adjourn the meeting at 4:50 pm.
