This staff report presents for public hearing and consideration, the approval of the 2011 Six Year Transportation Improvement Program (TIP).

### **BACKGROUND**

On an annual basis the City updates and puts forward to Council for approval the Six Year TIP. Once the TIP is approved, it may be amended at any time during the year. The projects that are included on the TIP, are projects funded through federal grants that have certain qualification standards. To be eligible for federal funds roads must be functionally classified above a rural minor collector. Projects listed in the TIP are the only projects that may be approved by the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Federal Transit Administration (FTA) to utilize federal funds. The projects listed are not the only projects that the City would like to see accomplished, however they are the qualified projects the City is hoping to utilize federal funds towards.

The staff has carried over all projects on the adopted 2010 TIP and no additional projects have been added. The intent is to finish the Municipal Park and Ride project by the end of this year, however, the staff felt it imperative to leave on the 2011 TIP as a cautionary measure.

### **RECOMMENDED ACTION**

The City Council is requested to conduct a first reading on the draft Six Year TIP, no action will be taken at this meeting.
