

**NOTICE OF CONTINUED SPECIAL MEETING/
CLOSED RECORD HEARING
OF THE CITY COUNCIL
RE: LANGLEY PASSAGE APPLICATION AND APPEALS**

The Langley City Council will hold a continued special meeting/closed record hearing on April 5, 2011, at 3:00 p.m., at Langley City Hall, 112 Second Street, Langley, Washington, to consider matters associated with the Langley Passage preliminary plat application/ related appeals and to take action thereon. The Langley Passage preliminary plat application is a proposal to subdivide 8.52 acres into 20 building lots and three non-buildable tracts, located in an area of Langley that converts automatically to the RS-7200 zoning district with the availability of sewers. Council action may include, but may not be limited to, any or all of the following activities: consideration of a previously-filed motion, a determination of the scope of the administrative record, whether to issue a final decision on the Langley Passage application denying it, approving it or approving it with conditions, oral argument by the appellants through their designated representatives, denying or granting previously filed appeals and entry of findings and conclusions to support the final decision.
