CITY OF LANGLEY DETERMINATION OF NONSIGNIFICANCE

Description of proposal: This proposal seeks to create a new Parks, Open Space and Trails Element for the City of Langley Comprehensive Plan. The element includes a detailed inventory of existing parks and open space features in and beyond the City of Langley, goals associated with the desired future parks and open space system, and actions to achieve this desired future. Strategies presented within the element include actions related parks, open space, trails, habitat, maintenance, land protection/ park creation, and signage.


