WATERFRONT HISTORY AND CIRCULATION PLAN

Jeff Arango made a presentation to the committee on the history of the central waterfront starting with the original plat of Langley in 1890. Key events in the history include the original 999' wharf at the foot of Anthes Avenue, the new wharf constructed at the foot of what is now Wharf Street and the deeding of the area that is now Seawall Park to the city.

Jeff Arango presented a waterfront circulation diagram that showed two possible connections between the Marina and Seawall Park, one along Sunrise Lane and the other along a boardwalk on the water side of the seawall. The funicular connection between the Marina and Cascade Avenue was also identified and discussed as well as existing and future "nodes" of activity including the foot of Anthes, Boy and Dog Park, the Funicular landing along Cascade and the marina uplands.

Jeff Arango also discussed how critical areas are required by state law to be integrated into the Shoreline Master Program (SMP) and how the committee needs to consider how the SMP supports the circulation plan.

Following the presentation the committee conducted a site visit and walk along the central waterfront including the marina uplands and along Sunrise Lane. The committee agreed that the Sunrise Lane connection is likely more feasible than the boardwalk connection and should be pursued.
