The City of Langley solicits interest from consulting firms with expertise in Streetscape Design, Urban Design, Landscape Architecture, Architecture, and Civil Engineering. Consultants will be considered for the following project.

Project Description

The Second Street Project involves streetscape design, urban design, public involvement, landscape design, and civil engineering for the redesign of Second Street in Downtown Langley. Second Street is a pedestrian oriented retail street and the project involves not only the reconstruction of the street, but also expanding opportunities for public space and improving the pedestrian environment with lighting, redesign sidewalks and seating areas, landscaping, undergrounding utilities and public art. Major features of the projects:

- Phase I: Conceptual Design, Planning and Public Involvement
- Phase II: Detailed design, engineering and permitting.
- Environmental planning and permitting.
- Assistance during bidding process.
- Coordination with WSDOT, as this is a federally funded project.
- Upon completion of design and permitting the firm may be considered for construction administration through a supplemental agreement.
