Masks Required In Langley Central Business Core

Proclamation Requiring The Use Of Facemasks In Langley, WA.

WHEREAS, a Local Emergency now exists due to the COVID-19 virus and that Emergency Operations are in effect, and this necessitates the utilization of emergency powers granted under RCW 38.52.070 and LMC Chapter 4.01.
And.

WHEREAS, While Island County and the City of Langley have made a great effort to reduce the spread of this virus, the COVID-19 virus still poses a substantial health risk to residents, essential service providers, and visitors and,

WHEREAS, local businesses have begun conducting limited activities in keeping with the Governor's Phased Opening Timetable and,

WHEREAS, there is a notable increase in off-island visitors, and residents in

the Central Business Core.

THEREFORE, I Tim Callison, Mayor of Langley acting within my emergency powers do hereby order the wearing of facemasks within the Central Business Core of the City of Langley. The boundaries of this order are from 4th Street to Seawall Park and Park Avenue to Wharf Street.

All efforts should be taken by those who are active within the Central Business Core, to comply with this order.

This order does not apply to those traveling through the Central Business Core in or on a vehicle or in private homes within the Core
