

## **19 June Seawall Park Committee Report to City Council)**

Using a Natural Northwest Beauty theme, the Seawall Park Committee recommends installation and study of the following:

1. Park furniture
2. Functional art and children's interactive art
3. Native landscaping
4. East end overhead shelter/events center
5. Functional and interpretive signage
6. East and west entrance pedestrian circulation.
7. Improving accessibility for different abilities
8. Maintenance/ replacement of east end wooden stairway

### **City Staff**

1. Assist advisory commissions in grant preparation and individual fund raising efforts

### **City Planning**

1. Functional and interpretive Signage
2. Main Street property owner's coordination/ involvement

### **Public Works**

1. Short and long term Park maintenance plan.
2. Maintenance /replacement of East end wooden stairs and fencing.
3. Accessibility
4. Seawall stability engineering review
5. Way finding and interpretive signage.

### **Langley Arts Commission**

1. Park upgrade fund raising through grants and initialization of a community fund raising capital campaign for park upgrades in the following areas:
2. Furniture
3. Shelter
4. Functional art
5. Develop a plan of action for City Council approval that includes a funding strategy, timeline of activities and estimated costs leading to the recommended upgrades to Seawall Park.
6. Develop and implement a City wide fundraising campaign

### **Open Spaces and Parks Commission**

1. Advise the City on the installation of Seawall Park upgrades.
2. Landscaping
3. Consider Development and Initiation of plan to raise Seawall grant and private funds.

### **Ad hoc Seawall Park Committee**

1. Will dissolve as of 17 June 2017
