5.04.060 Term of license and renewal.

There are three types of business licenses available within the city:

A. All annual business licenses required to be obtained pursuant to this chapter shall be issued on a basis and shall expire on June 30th of the year for which they are issued, with the exception of the 2010 license which shall be from January 1, 2010, until June 30, 2011. All such licenses shall be renewed annually with the fee due on the first day of July and payable no later than August 15th of that year. Application for renewal shall be made on the forms prescribed by the office of the clerk-treasurer. There shall be no reduction of any license fee because a new application is received late in the annual cycle; provided, that after January 1st of each year, the annual fee shall be reduced to one-half of the established fee for the remainder of the year for any new business. B. Seasonal business licenses may be applied for at any time, and shall be valid for a period not to exceed ninety (90) days in any calendar year. Food truck vendors approved pursuant to Section 12.22 of this Code shall be considered seasonal businesses.

C. Temporary business licenses may be applied for at any time, and shall be valid for a period not to exceed ten (ten) days. A temporary business license may be renewed for up to two (2) additional ten day periods within a calendar year.

Every license shall be personal to the licensee and shall not be assignable or transferable to any person.
